WELCOME

(Leader all others muted)

In Matthew 18: (19-21) Jesus said: "Again, I tell you truly that if two of you on the earth agree about anything you ask for, it will be done for you by My Father in heaven.

For where two or three gather together in My name, there am I with them".

Then Peter came to Jesus and asked, "Lord, how many times shall I forgive my brother who sins against me? Up to seven times?" Jesus answered, "I tell you, not just seven times, but seventy-seven times"

GREETING

(Leader all others muted)

OUR FELLOWSHIP

(Leader or Reader all others muted)

In 1 John 1:1-10 we read "That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we looked upon and have touched with our hands, concerning the word of life— the life was made manifest, and we have seen it, and testify to it and proclaim to you the eternal life, which was with the Father and was made manifest to us— that which we have seen and heard we proclaim also to you, so that you too may have fellowship with us; and indeed our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son Jesus Christ. And we are writing these things so that our joy may be complete". (Or choose another reading if you wish)

MUSIC (OPTIONAL)

(Leader introduces)

(Leader all others unmuted)

Either silently or aloud let us bring mind those we know and others in such situations and pray for them as we wish

Leader introduces

Silence/space for individual comments or prayers.

Jesus Said: "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid". (John 14:27). So we pray for all those who are facing fears, challenges, sadness, grief and distress.

SHARING THANKS

(Leader all others unmuted)

There are many things to be thankful for.

Sometimes we may not be able to perceive these amidst our own concerns, but they are there. Either silently or aloud let us bring mind those for whom give thanks. Thanks, for things that have happened, for families and friends who have supported us, for opportunities, for celebrations, for our friendships, and for the help and care we have received. Let us give thanks for these and pray for them as we wish.

Leader introduces

Silence/space for individual comments or prayers.

Paul Said in Romans 15:13 "May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit". So we bring to mind all the things we are thankful for, and give thanks for these, and all we receive in the Love of Christ.



SHARING HOPES

(Leader all others unmuted)

As we leave the past let us now look to the future and to our hopes and desires Either silently or aloud let us bring mind those things we hope for, for ourselves, family, friends, futures, things to happen in the world.

Leader introduces
Silence/space for individual comments or prayers

In Zephaniah 3:17 it is written "May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound in hope." Grant us lord the freedom to see these hopes and to work for them, so that all may be fulfilled.



SHARING COMMUNITY

(Leader all others unmuted)

In John 15:15 we read: "No longer do I call you servants, for the servant does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all that I have heard from my Father I have made known to you".

Here we bring to mind in prayer those things in our families and communities which we want to give thank for or concern us most

Leader introduces

Silence/space for individual comments or prayers

In your loving care Lord, please keep our loved ones, families, friends, and all people in our communities who we know, and also do not know safe in your care. Please watch over them always, and let good health, happiness, and good fortune come to them.

And as you share your peace Lord, let us now share our peace with each other

RESPONSE: And also with you. (All)
